



Family Take-Home Sheet
Jesus Raises Lazarus from the Dead
John 11:1-44

In today's lesson, your child learned that **God is in Charge of Everything!** Jesus' good friend, Lazarus, was very sick and about to die. After Lazarus died, Jesus and His friends, the disciples, went to the place where Lazarus was buried. Jesus was very sad and He cried when He got to the place where Lazarus was buried. Then, Jesus talked with God and thanked God for always hearing His prayers. After that, Jesus did something amazing. Even though Lazarus had been dead for four days, Jesus commanded that Lazarus come back to life! And because **God is in Charge of Everything** and Jesus is God, Lazarus did come back to life!

Review & Discussion

Here are some review points to help you engage your child in talking about the truth of Scripture. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in further discussion with your child.

1. What is the word we have learned about that means something very special and amazing that only God can do? (A miracle)
2. Jesus had a very good friend that was very sick. What was this man's name? (Lazarus)
3. Who came to tell Jesus that Lazarus was about to die? (Lazarus' sister)
4. When Jesus came to the place where Lazarus was buried, how long had Lazarus been dead? (1-2-3-4 days)
5. When Jesus found out that Lazarus died, what did He do? (He cried because Lazarus was His good friend.)
6. When Jesus came to the place where Lazarus was buried, He prayed to God. Did God hear Jesus' prayer? (Yes!)
7. What happened next? (Lazarus came back to life!)
8. Who is the only one that has the power to bring someone back to life? (God!)
9. **God is in Charge of Everything!**

Take it Home

Take time this week to make and use the instrument from the Little Village Memory Verse. Sing songs with your family and use the homemade instruments as well as anything else you can think of to make music as you sing praises to God. Praise God because **God is in Charge of Everything!**
